

Terms And Conditions

The Client : The company or individual requesting the services of Thanet Web Design.

Thanet Web Design: Primary designer/site owner & employees or affiliates.

General

Thanet Web Design will carry out work only where an agreement is provided either by email, telephone, mail or fax. Thanet Web Design will carry out work only for clients who are 18 years of age or above. An 'order' is deemed to be a written or verbal contract between Thanet Web Design and the client, this includes telephone and email agreements.

Website Design

Whilst every endeavour will be made to ensure that the website and any scripts or programs are free of errors, Thanet Web Design cannot accept responsibility for any losses incurred due to malfunction, the website or any part of it.

The website, graphics and any programming code remain the property of Thanet Web Design until all outstanding accounts are paid in full.

Any scripts, cgi applications, php scripts, or software (unless specifically agreed) written by Thanet Web Design remain the copyright of Thanet Web Design and may only be commercially reproduced or resold with the permission of Thanet Web Design.

Thanet Web Design cannot take responsibility for any copyright infringements caused by materials submitted by the client or used by the client in the future on their website.

We reserve the right to refuse any material of a copyrighted nature unless adequate proof is given of permission to use such material.

Any coding additions to website briefs provided will be carried out at the discretion of Thanet Web Design and may carry an additional cost. Where no charge is made by Thanet Web Design for such additions, Thanet Web Design accept no responsibility to ensure such additions are error free and reserve the right to charge an according amount for any correction to these or further additions.

The client agrees to make available as soon as is reasonably possible to Thanet Web Design all materials required to complete the site to the agreed standard and within the set deadline.

Thanet Web Design will not be liable for costs incurred, compensation or loss of earnings due to the failure to meet agreed deadlines.

Thanet Web Design will not be liable or become involved in any disputes between the site owner and their clients and cannot be held responsible for any wrongdoing on the part of a site owner. eg. Any disputes re content/images that have been provided to us for inclusion on the site.

Thanet Web Design will not be liable for any costs incurred, compensation or loss of earnings due to the work carried out on behalf of the client or any of the clients appointed agents.

Thanet Web Design will not be liable for any costs incurred, compensation or loss of earnings due to the unavailability of the site, its servers, software or any material provided by its agents.

A non-refundable deposit of 33% is required with all of our projects before any design work will be carried out. A further 33% is required after initial review. Once a website has been designed and completed the final balance of payment is then due in accordance with our payment terms.

There are no exceptions to this, (i.e If the client decides they no longer want the site, as they have commissioned the work and paid a deposit they are still obliged to pay for the work that has been done). Non-payment will result in legal action being taken if necessary. Once full payment is received for a website, it is assumed that the project has been

completed to the clients satisfaction and no refunds can be offered. We do offer free updates for a month after completion to allow for any final amendments that may be required.

Pay Monthly Payment Terms

On occasions and for bigger on-going contracts, we are able to offer a pay monthly package. These packages will be for a minimum term of 12 or 24 months.

Initial costs are payable upfront. The monthly costs start when the site is completed. If not received within 7 days, Thanet Web Design has the right to disable the website and any associated email accounts.

Once the site is built any further changes that Thanet Web Design is required to make for the client will be charged at a reduced rate of £10 per hour.

If a payment is not received on the designated day, there will be an additional charge of £15 for the first day and £5 for every subsequent day. Failure to make full payment, including charges, within 7 days of the missed payment date, will result in the website and website and any associated email accounts being disabled until payment is received. If after 30 days of the missed payment, the monthly balance and charges have not been received, Thanet Web Design hold the right to terminate the contract and seek legal action to recover the monies owed for the remainder of the contract including any charges incurred due to non-payment.

Database, Application and E-Commerce Development

Thanet Web Design cannot take responsibility for any losses incurred by the use of any software created for the client. Whilst every care has been taken to ensure products are problem free and accurate, the ultimate responsibility lies with the client in ensuring that all software is functioning correctly before use.

Payment of Accounts

A deposit is required from any new client before any work is carried out. It is the Thanet Web Design policy that any outstanding accounts for work carried out by Thanet Web Design or its affiliates are required to be paid in full, no later than 30 days from the date of the invoice unless by prior arrangement with Thanet Web Design. If a customer has an agreed pay date by Thanet Web Design, the customer must pay by this date, else the customer is subject to a 10% charge for each week that their invoice is unpaid

Once a deposit is paid and work completed you are obliged to pay the balance of payment in full. We will contact clients via email and telephone to remind them of such payments if they are not received when due.

If accounts are not settled or Thanet Web Design have not been contacted regarding the delay, access to the related website may be denied and web pages removed, we will then pass such cases to the Small Claims Court to pursue payment, non-payment can result in county court judgements (ccj's) being added to the clients credit rating.

Following consistent non-payment of an invoice our Solicitors will contact the client in question, with a view to taking the matter further and if need be to seek payment through legal procedures, and if necessary court summons.

Complaints Procedure

Informal procedure

Anyone who experiences a problem with their web service provided by Thanet Web Design should raise the matter directly using our online contact form to do so, giving sufficient information to locate the material (such as an url) and clearly outlining the grounds for complaint.

Thanet Web Design will approach the individual responsible for the material in question with a view to resolving the matter to the satisfaction of the complainant.

Formal complaints procedure
